What we're doing

As part of the programme to improve the quality of residential and rural roads across the county, we will be improving the condition and safety of Clappers Lane, Earnley. This process will involve removing the road surface layer and replacing with new materials.

When this will take place

The work is planned to start on **21st October 2014** and is expected to take one day to complete. Our hours of work will be between 6.00am to 6.30pm.

Before the works start, we will erect advance warning signs in the local area, letting you know any changes to the start date and marking the extent of the works.



Road Restrictions during the work

In order to protect our workforce and the public, a road closure will be in operation for the duration of the works from 6.00am to 6.30pm.

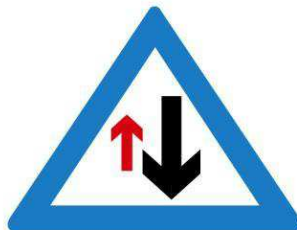
Information for residents

Please don't park on the road on the day of the works; this will help us avoid delays and abortive works.



Vehicle access

General advice



If possible please avoid walking on newly laid material;
If you do we suggest checking shoes before walking on carpets and flooring.
