The Parish Council is the first tier of local government. It was established in 1987 and can play a vital part in representing the interests of the community.

The Parish Council is non political and runs completely independently from the District and County Council

YOUR COUNCILLORS

The civil parish consists of the villages of Somerley, Almodington and Earnley. A total of five councillors and we attempt to have representatives for each different area. Contact details are always on display via our website, as well as on the Council notice boards in various locations throughout the parish. Contact the council office if you need details.

YOUR MEETINGS

The whole Council meets on the fourth Thursday of every other month, at 7.15pm in the community room at Bracklesham Barn, Beech Avenue.

Members of the public are welcome to attend and to ask questions during a specific time set aside for them. The public are also most welcome to attend these committees:

Planning Committee - 4th Thursday of the month except August & December when no meetings take place,

Employment Committee - as required

Standards Committee - as required
