


Best 4 Chichester

Reasons for a Northern route:

1. **Less traffic congestion and hold ups for the majority of local communities**, with anxiety free crossing at all junctions on the A27 for local journeys.
2. **Relieving a critical blockage in the South Coast trunk road** from Folkestone (Kent) to Honiton (Devon) by giving a clear, faster, safe drive for **42% through traffic** (Highways England figure).
3. **Reduced danger, pollution and noise** all so close to our City, schools and hospitals because of queuing and heavy traffic.

4. **Reduced visual impact** as a northern bypass could be landscaped, set in cuttings and routed almost entirely across open undeveloped land south of, and outside of, the Southdowns National Park.
5. **Reduced disruption and inconvenience** by avoiding, more traffic lights, drive through roundabouts, restricted access to the A27, high unsightly flyovers south of the City and stop/start traffic.
6. **Benefit of 40% plus traffic bypassing Chichester** on a northern route would remove heavy construction work on the A27 bypass, saving us all up to 3½ years of noise, diversions, chaos, hold-ups and dirt.



The **South Coast Trunk Road**, improved by the vital link of the Northern Bypass is very important to the economy of all of Sussex and beyond, **This is NOT just a Chichester issue.** It deserves **national attention** and support by those who have a vested interest in this route.



Chichester, our beautiful and historic city is under threat.

Highways England has consulted about improvements to the A27 south of Chichester. It did not include a northern route.

Facts published by Highways England show a northern route would be safer, faster and cause minimal construction traffic delays.

A northern route would be a good deal for local people and the nation.

The southern routes proposed would be a disaster:

- Flyovers destroying neighbourhoods and city views. The flyovers would be at junctions A, B, C and D.
- No improvement to the Portfield roundabout (F) although there is already considerable congestion.
- Local access to A27 restricted. Traffic would be forced to use unsuitable routes through local communities.
