Sidlesham Schools Admissions Register

I am now onto the second volume of the Schools Admissions Register 1938-48.

In addition to 'Returned North' the following were also given as 'Cause for Leaving':
'Left with permission of WSCC to do agricultural work'
'Don't like coming to school' !

The previous volume up to April 1938 gave me 114 names, 28 of whom 'returned north'.
80 more names so far (up to September 1940), 22 of whom 'returned north' or to South Wales.
