

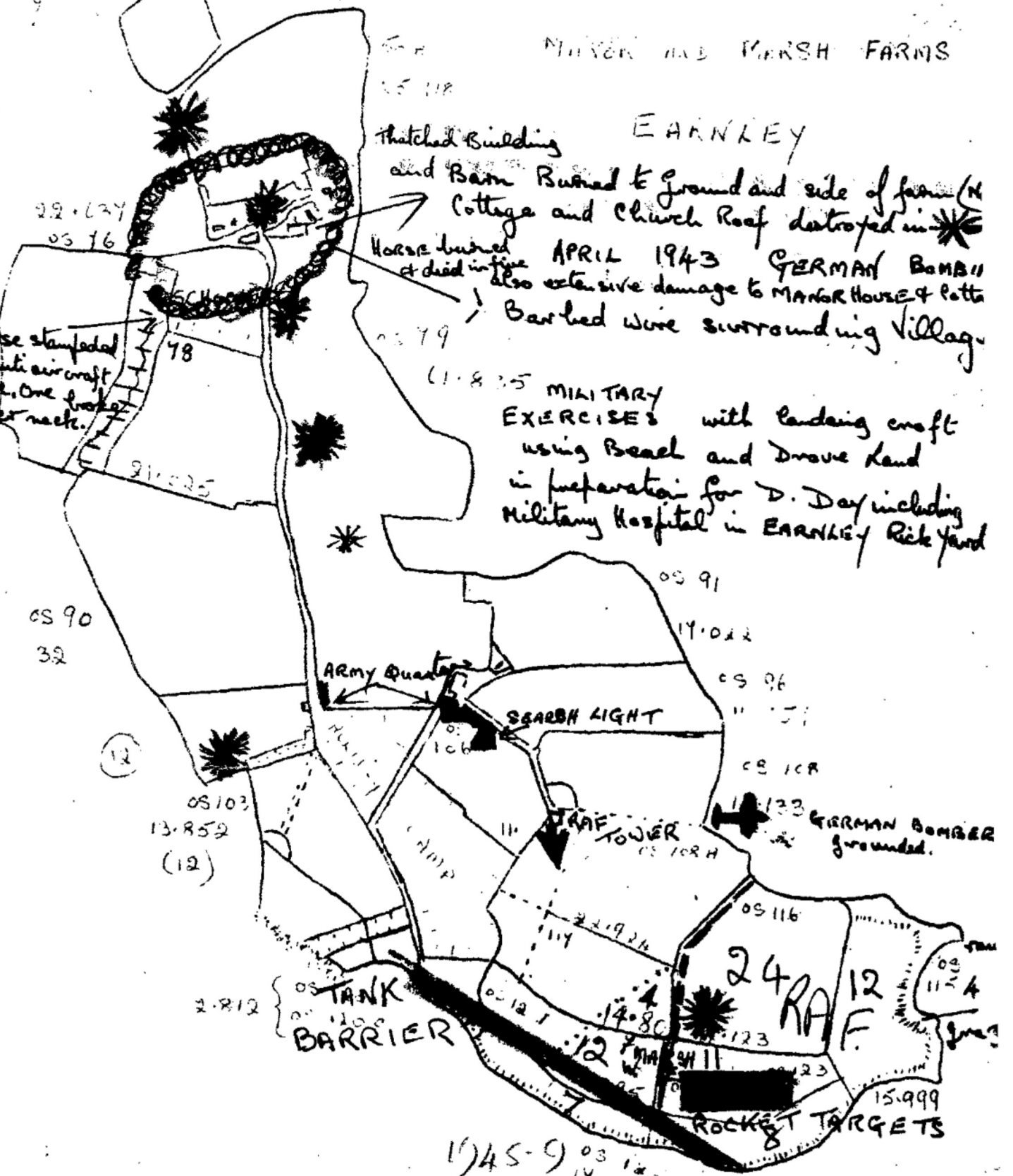
MILNER AND MARSH FARMS

EARNLEY

Thatched Building and Barn Burned to Ground and side of farm (N) Cottage and Church Roof destroyed in APRIL 1943 GERMAN BOMBING also extensive damage to Manor House & Potts Barbed wire surrounding Village

Horse buried & died in fire
MILITARY EXERCISES with landing craft using Beach and Drive Land in preparation for D. Day including Military Hospital in EARNLEY Rick Yard

Horse stampeded in anti aircraft fire. One broke her neck.



TANK BARRIER.

A structure of steel pipes erected in 1940. Grass land reduced for Agric purposes because there was no access through the barrier. Fields affected West Marsh

R.A.F. TARGET AREA 1945-9

Rockets and Machine gun firing range. BOMBING out at sea. AREA. 55 acres plus 5 Acres Rough grazing.
