## Chalder Station

Thanks to the 10 volunteers who help to clear undergrowth from the platform in July. This time we laid weed control matting in the hope that this might slow the growth of bramble and other vegetation. Next Spring we hope to undertake a more permanent restoration of the platform.

Today we met a representatives of Trackwork, a company providing infrastructure to the rail network, to discuss the possible re-instatement of track alongside the platform at Chalder Station. Govia Thames Link are also involved in the discussions. We have also had two estimates to restore the waiting room. All subject to planning permission.

## **Exhibition at the Novium**

Dates for the exhibition on The Selsey Tramway Exhibition at The Novium Museum are confirmed as June 2024 until March 2026.

A film will be made featuring YouTube footage of the Tramway - only railcar available unless anyone knows of locomotion footage? We also have video of two interviews with former employees and a description of a journey. Finally the Selsey Shantymen have been rehearsing 'The Sidlesham Snail'!

We have also visited the Colonel Stephens Museum at Tenterden to discuss the loan of artefacts.
